SUMMER CAMPS: BLOSSOMING BUDS PRESCHOOL

Blossoming Bud Preschool's summer camps are full of fun and engaging themed weeks. Our daily routine will be a lot like our everyday school schedule to keep continuity for children who attend preschool. BBP will be supplying a healthy snack each day (with an occasional Popsicle on those hot days) and the students will need to provide their own lunch. All programs are Monday – Friday from 9:00am-1:00pm.

Each camp will be age-integrated with an age requirement of 2.5 years old by the first day of attending camp. Our summer camps are during the months of July and August. To hold a spot in a camp, a non-refundable \$45 deposit is due per camp. The deposit will be applied to the attended camp.

**Please note, if we have less than 4 children attending a camp it will be canceled.

Each camp is \$245/week

□ New to BBP summer camps? Please include a \$25 application fee along with our registration packet (If you attended last year, we still have your registration. If you attended 2 years ago, you will need to fill it out again. Thanks you.)

Other important information:

- 10% sibling discount when enrolling together for the same camp
- \$25/week diaper fee for non-potty trained students
- A non-refundable \$45 deposit is due per camp to hold a spot
- All July camp tuition due **June 15**th
- All August camp tuition due **July 15**th
- Please fill out the entire registration to sign-up for our camps (if you are new to BBP)
- If you are not new to BBP, please fill out page #2 and turn it in with your deposit check.

Once you decide on the weeks you will be attending please fill out your student's information, check off the camps your child will be attending, include your \$25 non-refundable deposit per camp and drop off this page only (at BBP or BBC.) Enrolling at Blossoming Buds Preschool Summer Camps

- A. Blossoming Buds does not reimburse money for days/weeks that are missed regarding sickness, holidays, etc.
- B. We asked to be paid monthly on the 15th of the month this is prepayment. You may mail your payment with a postmark of the due date or you may bring it in with your child.
- C. Returned checks will result in a \$25.00 service fee.
- D. Students that are not potty trained are charged \$25/week session.

Hours of Operation for Blossoming Buds and Pick-up/drop-off Rules

- A. Blossoming Buds Preschool will be open from 9:00am-1:00pm Monday thru Friday.
- B. At 9:00am a teacher will open the school doors and greet the waiting students. At this time you may choose to escort your child to their cubby or we will bring them in for you.
- C. Please do not park in the driveway and load/un-load zone if you want to bring your student in the school.
- D. It is really important for the children to be picked up on time at 1pm.
- E. There will be a \$5.00 charge for the first 10 minutes late, a dollar for every minute after the first 10 minutes. This late charge will be added to your following month bill.
- F. When school is over we will get the children ready to go and will excuse them as soon as we see you outside.

Health Policies

Illness Policy

Please be considerate of the other families and keep ill children at home. Use your best judgment. If a child comes to Blossoming Buds and has a temperature, rash, drainage from the eye, diarrhea, vomiting, sore throat, severe cough, severe headache, etc the parents will be contacted immediately to pick-up their child. Germs can spread fast in a preschool even though we sanitize daily and when needed hourly.

When unsure please feel free to contact Tristan and she will let you know what to do. Blossoming Buds will never give children medication that was not brought by the parents. If a child is sick and the doctor has given the parents permission that it is safe for the child to come back to preschool we will give the child medication if needed. Please bring the medication and the dosage and we will make sure to give the child the right amount at the right time.

Please note that most children, when sick, are not contagious after 3 days, but if the child still has a lot of symptoms (fever, coughing, severe running nose, sneezing, tired, nauseous, etc.) we ask them not to be brought to preschool. Once the child has a little bit of a running nose that is when it is safe to bring them back. Thank you for understanding.

Hand Washing Policy

The children and staff will be required to wash their hands before eating anything and after using the restroom. Blossoming Buds will have sanitation wipes and gel around the facility to make sure the children and staff always has access to cleaning their hands/face.

Medication/Allergy Information

If your child has any medical problem that may need attention while in Blossoming Buds care we highly advise the parents to keep an extra set of medication with us. We will keep the medication in a locked box that will only be used on your child. For the child's safety, we do not allow the medication to be stored in the child's cubby. Please write down any medical problems your child has on the lines provided and turn it in.

Important General Information for Blossoming Buds

Memos

Always check your child's backpack to see if there are any "Memos" from school. Every once in awhile we will send Memos home; reminders, help we may need, changes in schedule, holidays coming up, etc. This will be our way of communicating with the parents of what is ahead. Always feel free to call us with any questions regarding Memos.

Clothing

Please make sure your child comes prepared in the appropriate attire everyday. We will be doing a lot of arts and crafts and other activities that may cause them to get dirty. Blossoming Buds is not responsible for any clothing that gets ruined under our supervision. Also be aware of the weather and dress them accordingly. We highly suggest leaving an extra outfit and underwear in the child's cubby just in case of an accident. Put the extra clothing in a bag with their name on it and we will keep it in their cubby. During the summer program we will be spending a lot of time outside so please protect them from getting sunburned: sunscreen, hat, sunglasses, etc.

Staffing (Very Important)

Blossoming Buds Preschool's will have 2 people on staff. It is **very important** that the families understand that the personnel of Blossoming Buds cannot take care of your children outside of Blossoming Buds (baby-sit, nanny, etc). We do not want any of the children to have 'special treatment' by our employees. We want all the children to be treated the same. Our employees also cannot be trained through Blossoming Buds and then be hired as a nanny or home school provider for your family. This would result in a fine and termination of the employee. Please respect our policies and abide by them.

Child Abuse Reporting Law Requirements

By law we are required to report any indication of child abuse, being emotional, physical, sexual abuse, child neglect or exploitation. The director, Tristan Christophilis, has taken classes on child abuse and knows the direct signs of any abuse. The director would not hesitate to contact CPS if any of the signs are visible. Abuse is a major issue and will be taken very seriously.

We are not obligated to inform parents if the police or CPS is notified.
